Round #1

Grants & Loans Available

RUS - up to **\$2.325 billion**

NTIA - up to **1.6 billion** to be awarded via three Categories:

1. *Broadband Infrastructure* **up to \$1.2 billion**
2. *Public Computer Center* **up to \$50 million**
3. *Sustainable Broadband Adoption* **up to \$150 million**

Note: \$200 million was available to augment any of the individual categories during Round #1 or that can be used pursuant to subsequent NOFAs.

Federal Awards To Date (as of March 2010)

NTIA - 61 projects totaling \$991.2 million, including: Middle mile with 34/\$871.8 million; PCC 18/\$52.4 million; and SBA 9/\$66.9 million

RUS - 68 projects totaling \$1.067 billion

Total Awarded to State of Missouri = \$2 million total

\$1.5 million for broadband data collection and mapping activities, and approximately **\$470,000** for planning activities

State of Missouri Matching & Cost Sharing = \$493,346
